Responsibilities also include facilitating the seminar/webinar, arranging refreshments and lunches for seminar attendees, working with the treasurer for expenses, the membership coordinator(s) on announcement postcards, registration and payments, and the public relations committee on raffles and door prizes. President-elect will also perform the duties of the president in the event of his/her absence.
