

Begin transplanting plants in the landscape, keeping them out of the ground as short a time as possible.

Plant bare root and balled and burlap wrapped plants. Be sure to keek them well watered.

- Avoid pruning spring blooming plants.
- Use a dormant oil spray on dormant fruit trees and woody ornamentals.
- Roses can be pruned in late January.

If hard freeze is predicted wter lawn and ornamenal plants 24 to 48 hours before the freeze to improve cold protection.

Plant seeds indoors or in a greenhouse.

Vegetables to plant: beets, broccoli, cabbage, carrot, cauliflower, celery, Chinese cabbage, mustard, bunching onions, English peas, radishes and turnips.

Ânnuals to plant: carnations, pansies, petunias, snapdragons, delphiniums, larkspar, dianthus and foxgloves.

News from Around the Shores St. Augustine Shores Service Corporation's **Board of Directors December Meeting**

The St. Augustine Shores Service Corporation's Board of Directors held their December 11 regular meeting and conducted the following business:

Approval of the Minutes – November 13, 2014.

Treasurers Report – Approved and accepted for audit. 2.

The ACC Committee had 1 meeting in the month of November and the ACC Committee approved: 1 carport, 1 sun room, 1 pergola, 2 new homes, 1 pool enclosure, 1 pool, 2 screen enclosures, 1 shed. Total approved YTD 118.

4. The Board heard an update on the pool re-marcite project.

The General Manager informed the Board that he was in possession of the performance bond and the building permit for the project.

The project commenced Saturday December 6. Jim LePetrie, P.E., Wet Engineering, inspected the site December 12 and approved the progress made.

The General Manager provided the Board with a preliminary draft of the Bid Specification Document for the Pool Bath House Renovation Project on the demolition, floor plan, ceiling plan, plumbing and lighting.

He informed the Board that the final draft will be complete December 19 and the Request For Bids will be issued. Deadline for completion is still March 31so the pool can open on time with totally renovated facilities.

6. The Board was provided with the adjusted Personnel Policies and voted to approve them. The complete review and update of all policies are now done.

7. The General Manager informed the Board that Fire Services had postponed the mitigation work for 6 to 8 months due to equipment issues and other commitments.

He had contacted Forestry Services Supervisor Gary Carpenter for an update to see if progress had been made to set a new date. In preparation of resuming the work in the buffers behind several houses a Minor Modification Application has been completed and the General Manager and Carpenter submitted it to St. Johns County. However no specific date has been set as yet. All affected properties will be notified once a date is set.

8. In New Business concerning Committees the Board was informed that Lance Conner has been appointed Election Committee Chair. The Board will serve as the Search Committee.

9. The Board was presented a Management issue with the Corporations 2006 GMC Truck. The truck has 146500 miles on it and needs computer controls replaced, 4 tires, axle and oil pan leaks repaired. The repair estimates are in the \$1500 - \$1800 range. Checking with Ford, Chevrolet and Dodge, the trade in value of the truck would be in the \$6337 to \$9000 range. Ford offered \$9000. The Board voted to buy a new Ford Truck recognizing expensive repairs plus the loss of trade in value to drive the 2006 GMC another year did not make sense. The Dreux Isaac Reserve Fund Study had recommended considering replacement this year or next and funds were allocated for this purchase.

10. The General Manager provided a Deed Violation packet to each Board member that included the initial report of the violations, a printed copy of the entry into the Pride system, a printed copy of the follow up detail from the County Code Enforcement Department and a follow up report on violations reported in the prior month which explained the process.

News From Around St. Johns County St. Johns County Offering Vehicle Beach **Access Passes at Preseason Discounts**

St. Johns County will offer 2015 vehicle beach access passes at the discounted prices of \$30 for a St. Johns County resident pass, \$40 for a non-resident pass, and \$20 for a handicap pass, beginning November 24, 2014 through March 1, 2015. Passes will be available during normal business hours at the following locations: Tax Collector's Main Office, 4030 St. Lewis Speedway, Tax Collector's Dupont Center, 6658 US1 South, Tax Collector's Julington Creek Office, 725 Flora Branch Blvd, Tax Collector's Ponte Vedra Office, 5430 Palm Valley Road, Tax Collector's Hastings Office, 6195 S. Main Street, St. Johns County Beach Services Office, 901 Pope Road, and the Pier Gift Shop, 350 A1A Blvd.

Residents must present a valid I.D. with a St. Johns County address or present proof of property tax payments in St. Johns County. When requesting a handicap pass, a vehicle with a handicap hang-tag or license plate must be presented. 100% Disabled Military are eligible for a free annual pass by presenting military I.D. or a letter from Veterans Affairs (VA).

Vehicle beach access passes will be required between March 1 and September 30. Beginning March 2, prices will increase to \$40 for St. Johns County residents, \$60 for non-residents, and \$30 for handicap. Additional passes, such as daily passes, will be available for purchase on March 1, 2015 at all beach access ramps. 
