Store Hogs to £121.00 - Grazing Ewes to £90.50

An excellent entry of 430 hogs forward to a top price of £121.00

Grazing Ewes (44), the sale kicked off with 44 grazing ewes forward, which hit a top of £90.50 for D & M Ridd & Son, with others from AJ May to £73.50, PG Potter saw a pen to £72.00 & D & M Ridd & Son saw their second pen of Exmoor Horns to £69.50.

Cull Rams (5), topped at £65.00 for D Potter.

Store Hogs (381), sold to an average of £91.29. If you took out some of the long-term small lambs, you could comfortably bring that average to exceed £100. Top of the day from A Heal of £121.00, others from C Raffe to £115.00, a run from R Cowling hit £114.50, £114.00 & £113.00. V Ellicott saw his top to £111.00 and MR Westcott to £110.50. D & PR Rawle saw theirs top at £109.00 and C Dapling to £107.00.

This trade continues to fly at a remarkable pace and we encourage all to review any hogs they may have and again any ewes if they have lost lambs or not likely to be bred from again; it is a suitable time to sell as the demand continues to hold firm and prices hold strong.

Cutcombe Market Report – Wednesday 17th March 2021

Prime New Season Lambs to £138.80 – Store Hogs to £168.00 - Grazing Ewes to £138.00

776 sheep forward for sale at Cutcombe this week and what a trade! It just continues to rise & set new records here at Cutcombe.

Prime New Season Lambs (17), from TJ Buckingham, were the first through the ring and sold to 312ppk to achieve £138.80.

Prime Hogs (215), look very well sold with the top of the day at £168.00 for Haydon House Partnership, a new record for us at Cutcombe.

A mixed bag of hogs forward, perhaps didn't have the shine and quality that we saw a fortnight ago and hence the SQQ at 265.6ppk. The top of the day at 285.0ppk from I Palmer & Son and RJ Hawkins.

Leading prices for a run from DW & J Jones to £159.80, who followed up with others to £149.00 and £145.00 with JR Richards & Son selling a 62kg Exmoor Horn to £154.50, S Norman saw his top pen of 66kg hogs away at £148.00 and RF & SA Davey sold a pen to £144.50, closely followed by WH Toze & Son at £144.00.

A run from T Yandle were well sold with the first pen of 55kgs hoggs to £143.00, with others to £135.00 (50kgs) and £130.00 (50kgs). Mrs J Scripps saw pens to £139.00 & £130.00 and J Scott saw a single to £136.50 and MJ Buckingham, a 52kgs Exmoor Horns to £133.50.

Medium weights, the list goes on with the medium weights: 45.5kgs from J Pugsley & Son at £124.80, RF Jones saw a run to £119.50 for 44kgs with J Pugsley & Sons second & third pens to £115.20 & £111.50 being 42.5kgs & 41.5kgs.

A pen from RJ Hawkins to £114.00 (40kgs) and J Leonard a pen of 45.0kgs to £113.50. These were matched by a pen from WH Toze & Son (40kgs) and others from Miss P Marke to £110.50 (40kgs).

Light weights, 39kgs from J Scott to £107.50, 38kgs from Mrs J Scripps to £105.50 and I Palmer & Son a pen of 36kgs to £102.50. Looking extremely well sold again.

Store Hoggs (73), to a top of £121.50 for ET. JA & S Kennen, who sold others to £99.50. O Robins saw a pair to £114.80, C Raffe £107.50 & MJ Buckingham £107.00. K Stevens to £105.00 and J Leonard to £104.50. Store lambs continue at a blistering pace and many more could easily be sold.

Grazing Ewes (453), what a trade for these again this week! The top of the day from RF Jones at £138.00, further pens from the same home to £132.50 & £128.50. RJ Hawkins saw a pen of 6 to £129.80, DW & J Jones saw his run away to £129.50 & others at £128.50.

W Ellicott managed to split the run at £129.00 with a pen and T Yandle sold a single to £125.00. RW Tucker & Son saw ewes at £120.00 & D Knight with ewes to £119.00.

Cull Rams (18), to £135.00 for V Ellicott, others to £126.50 for RK Hawkins, RF & SA Davey to £120.00 for two rams, MR Scott & Son £112.00, C Raffe £105.50 and D Knight £100.00.

The cull rams again, a serious demand for these and certainly all looking extremely well sold.
