Miss Bri hails from Pennsylvania where she began her early training. A summer intensive at the School of American Ballet led to a scholarship to Boston Ballet where she performed in *Swan Lake* and *The Nutcracker*.

In 2008, she joined Orlando Ballet's second company and advanced the following year to Orlando Ballet's professional company. Through the course of six seasons, she performed the leading roles of Odette from *Swan Lake*; Sugar Plum, Dew Drop, and Snow Queen in *The Nutcracker*; Ursula in *The Little Mermaid*; Witch from *Snow White*; and Zulma from *Giselle*.

Miss Bri joined Ballet Arizona in 2015 to perform in Balanchine's *Rubies, Symphony in 3* and original works by director Ib Anderson. Earle Smith's *The Nutcracker*; as well as the principle role in George Balanchine's *Valse Fantaisie*.
