FROM FR. FRANCISCO 'S DESK

Dear brothers and sisters,

This coming week, we will celebrate the memorial of the first US Citizen who became a Saint – St. Frances Xavier Cabrini. This woman, who until Mother Teresa or St. Teresa of Calcutta, had opened the most religious houses in the world, came as a missionary to this country sent by Pope Leo XIII. She always wanted to be a missionary to China, but God had a different plan. When she arrived at an audience with Pope Leo XIII, he told her: "Not to the East but to the West". And that is how, Mother Cabrini arrived in little Italy New York at the end of the 1800s. She is a source of consolation for all those who feel that they want to do good, but it seems that they are not welcomed – I say this because when she arrived in New York, the Bishop told her that he did not need any help and to turn around but she insisted that the Pope sent her, so she will stay. And thank God she did. Mother Cabrini opened Hospitals, Schools, Orphanages, etc. ... The seminary where I was formed as a priest is a former orphanage of Mother Cabrini. We always recounted in the seminary how through her intercession that house became a seminary to form priests when it was about to be closed and sold. Let us ask her intercession so that we may always have the courage to do what God is inviting us to do.



Next Saturday we will have our Casino Night. I invite all adults to participate and have fun and at the same time to help the parish through this fundraiser. We have started our Consecration Class on Thursdays at 7:30 PM in Mother Angela. Also, next weekend is the annual collection for the food pantry and also annual distribution. Siempre contamos en el seminario cómo, a través de su intercesión, esa casa se convirtió en un seminario para formar sacerdotes cuando estaba a punto de cerrarse y venderse. Pidamos su intercesión para que siempre podamos tener el coraje de hacer lo que Dios nos invita a hacer.

El próximo sábado tendremos nuestra Noche de Casino. Invito a todos los adultos a participar y divertirse y, al mismo tiempo, a ayudar a la parroquia a través de esta recaudación de fondos. Peçamos-lhe intercessão para que tenhamos sempre a coragem de fazer o que Deus nos convida a fazer.




