Eligibility:

1. Applicant must be attending an accredited college or university or applying to an accredited college or university to attend during the 2022-23 academic year.

2. Applicant must have SOFA status as the spouse of an active duty, reserve, guard,

retired, or DoD civilian currently stationed on Okinawa.

Important Information:

1. The Marine Thrift Shop will award 1 \$1,000 scholarship to a spouse.

Scholarship will be paid directly to the spouse to be used for education expenses. Should the recipient fail to attend college or university during the 2022-23 academic year, the scholarship will be forfeited.

2. The scholarship will be awarded without the service member's rank and the applicant's and service member's age, race, gender, religion, sexual orientation or ethnicity being considered.

3. Applications will be judged on: volunteer and community service history, work history, extracurricular, honors and awards and essay content (to include content as well as spelling and grammar).

4. All of the applicant's personally identifiable information will be unknown to the judges until after judging is complete.

5. Only complete applications turned in by the deadline will be considered.
