


In the good and bad issues of life that will come your way always give God the praise in both. He is your only way to a peaceful mind. He gives rest and leads you into that unspeakable joy.

PRAISE & WORSHIP

Praise is universal! It is because of what God has done.

Praise is the process of recalling the past, especially the presence and activity of God in the history of His people. Remembering God's work in the past can lead to praise, rejoicing, and hope for the future. Hallelujah... God, Himself remembers! The celebration for honor and adoration of God, in the power of the Holy Spirit... individually and/or corporately (Ex. 15:1-2; Luke 1:67-68; Rev. 15:2-3).

Worship is intimate! It is because of who God is.

God alone is worthy of worship; the worship of other gods is forbidden (cf. Ex. 20:3). The supreme reason for human existence is to worship God for His love, greatness, and saving grace. To worship God is a divine command (cf. Matt. 4:10; 1 Tim. 2:8). Worship is the response of God's people (cf. Ex. 4:31; Heb. 12:28). True worship is not mechanical repetition of rituals (automatic/emotionless/involuntary) but should

be wholehearted and reverent. It should be based upon trustful and obedient lives because obedience is itself to be seen as an act of worship.


1. How important is praise and worship within one's life and within the church body?

a. Very important, because it is a reflection of our gratitude of what God has done for us and also because of His infinite existence (cf. Rom. 12:1-2; Isaiah 40:28). Worship not only gives God what is due to Him but also results in many benefits for His people.

2. Is praise & worship only for Sundays?

- a. No, it is a way of life (cf. Job 1:20-21; Acts 16:25-26; 1 Thess. 5:16-18).
- 3. During emotional issues, illness, and even death, what role does praise & worship play?
 - a. It plays a primary role because God is our refuge and our strength (Ps. 46:1-3; 91:1-7). In other words, we find safety and courage by trusting in Him... He is always present to help us in our troubles (cf. Ps. 33:1-5; Jer. 31:13-14).
- 4. Is praise and worship only for the musical teams within the church or should the local body participate?
 - a. The whole body should praise and worship the Lord (Ex. 15:1-13; Eph. 5:18-21).
- 5. What Bible verses would you suggest those that are going through read concerning praising and worshiping their way to peace of mind?
 - a. Acts 16:25-34; Ps. 96:1-6; Isaiah 26:1-4; Heb. 11:6, 12:28-29; 2 Cor. 4:7-12; Joshua 1:6-9)








When man's opinion has declared us "guilty", there is One who can be touched by our worship and forgive our sins!
