- There is a discrepancy in The accounts up to the 23rd March.
- There are 34 rents outstanding as of 9th April, this does not include those members who are in isolation but not paid. List passed to field stewards 20/05/2020 rents have now all been paid
- RJ has started to redirect all bank and invoices. He has found that most addresses had not been changed to John Bowerman 17/06/2020 addresses now been changed RJ
- The utility companies have set us up with internet access to supply our own readings and manage our accounts - completed RJ

Store/Rota
