

 - b. What objection is the Saviour anticipating?
 - c. <u>Application</u>: *Christ knows your heart*.
- 2. <u>Comfort (v. 65)</u>
 - a. Why should the disciples not be discouraged when many reject the Lord Jesus Christ?
 - b. How may the disciples of Christ be empowered to endure the attacks of unbelievers?


