Churches this year are using their facilities similar to use in 2019.

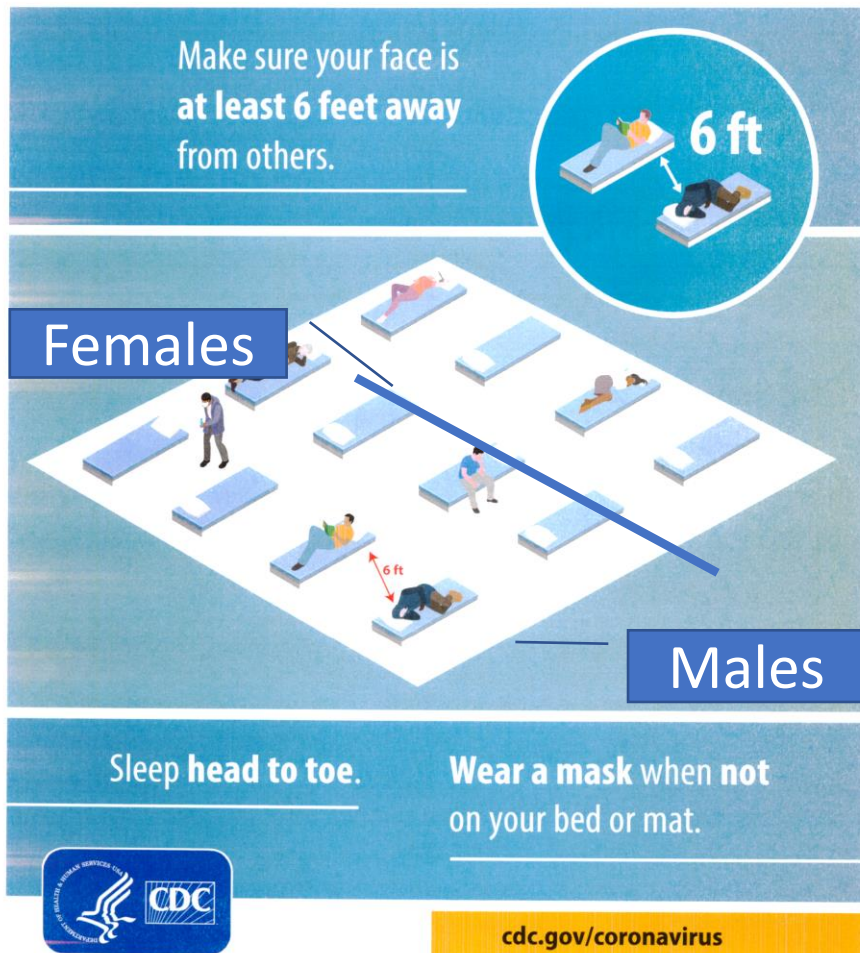


Shelter Precautions

How You can Protect Others from COVID-19 in Shelters: In General Sleeping Areas



- Tape Xs will be on floor to show how far apart each mattress will be
- Each guest will have 2 chairs to use, placed between mattresses
- Personal belongings may be placed under the chair
- Guests will sleep head to toe
- Males and females will be separated by a partition

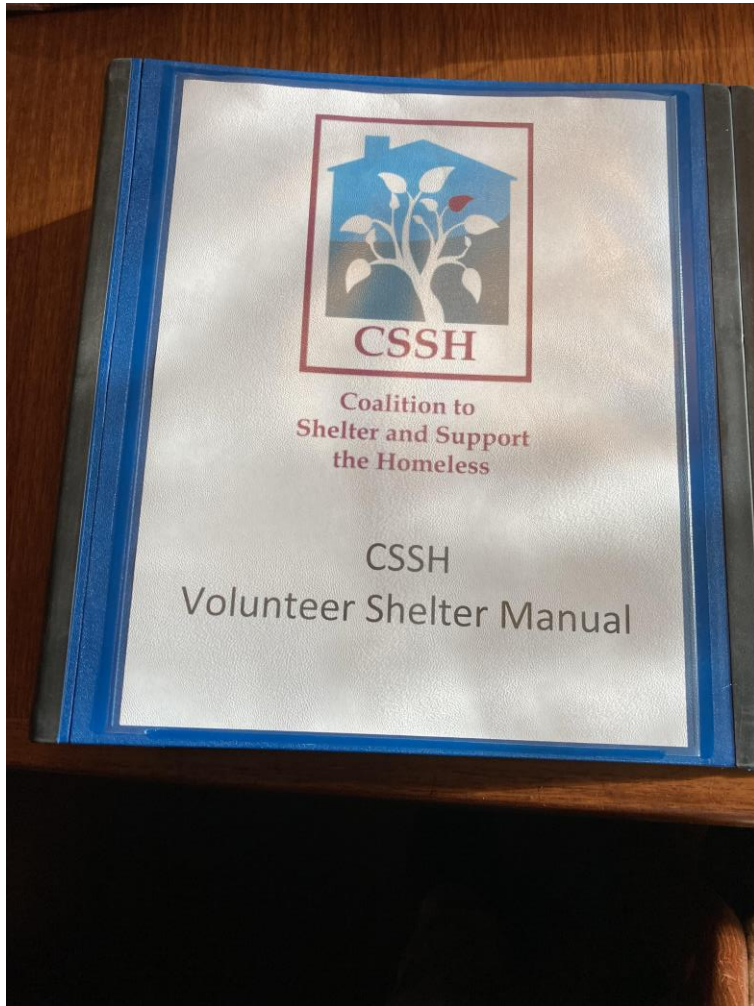
Changes from 2020
