Our dear friend David Joel Pichler died unexpectedly at the young age of 34 in February 2011. In an effort to honor his memory in a way consistent with his life experiences and values, a group of his family and friends have created the *David J. Pichler Memorial Scholarship Award* at Stuyvesant High School. The \$5,000 scholarship is awarded annually to a graduating senior at Stuyvesant High School who has excelled in mathematics and plans to attend Dartmouth College the following fall.

The scholarship highlights many aspects of David's life. Both David and his sister Judy graduated from Stuyvesant, and their mother Natalie is a retired teacher from the New York City Public School system. David graduated from Dartmouth with a degree in Mathematics and went on to use that knowledge towards a successful career in finance. We hope to be able to lighten the financial burden of many future Dartmouth students and help them realize their educational dreams.
