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A Deepening of God's Indictments Against Israel

- •Dealing Falsely 6:7 with 5:7
- •Condemnation of priests 6:9 with 5:1
- •Defilement of Ephraim 6:10 with 5:3
- •Harlotry metaphor 6:10 with 5:4

God's Response to Breaking Covenant

- •Their love is like the morning mist:
- •Israel is empty of any true worship to God
- •There is no heart change before God
- •Their love is thin and unsubstantial

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God's Response to Breaking Covenant

- •Key Verse 6:6
- •There is not "hesed" love
- *Faithful loving-kindness
- *There is no knowledge of God
- •Israel is merely religious

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God's Response to Breaking Covenant

- •There is no life transformation
- •See Amos 5:21-24; Isa 1:11-17; Ps 51:16-17

- •They have broken covenant
- Unfaithful
- •Evil doers
- ·Wicked schemers
- •Given to prostitution

- •Shechem Josh 20:7; Duet 19 a city of refuge

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A Catalogue of Crimes vs 7-10

- ·Places mentioned
- ·Note!
- *Joshua 24 Shechem was the place that Israel confirmed the covenant which they have now broken in Shechem

More Crimes -6:11-7:8

•Judah is implicated in these crimes as well

NOTE! God still desires to heal and redeem His people

He is still faithful – see 2 Tim 2:11-13

BUT... those people!!

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More Crimes -6:11-7:8

- •Sin keeps them from healing and renewal
- ·Practice deceit
- ·Break into houses
- •Rob people in the streets

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More Crimes -6:11-7:8

Crimes of the leaders -7:3-7

- •Kings and princes are delighted by evil and even join in
- •Leaders are leading away from God instead toward God

More Crimes -6:11-7:8

Crimes of Leaders 7:3-7

Imagery of the Oven

- •Their passion to sin burns like an oven
- *They are burning to sin, anxious for it.
- *They hold festivals in order to enjoy sin

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More Crimes -6:11-7:8

Crimes of Leaders 7:3-7

- •Purveyors of deceit and intrigue
- •Assassinations of the royal household
- •See 2 Kings 15:23-25

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More Crimes -6:11-7:8

Their sin has not gone unnoticed!

- •See 6:10; 7:2
- •God sees their sin and takes note
- •Breaking covenant results in judgment
- •See Lev 26:27-33

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Breaking Covenant-Foreign Policy – 7:8-16

God's judgement upon Israel

- •They do not seek God anymore, even when He still offers His "hesed" love.
- ${}^{\textstyle \bullet} \text{God's}$ promise of destruction will come to pass
- *See Lev 26:27-33; Deut 28:64-68

Conclusion/Summary

God desires that we live in relationship with Him, not in religion.

God offers His "hesed" love to us, asking that we reflect that "hesed" love back to Him; no pretending.

We have a choice to make: how will we live? In loving-kindness and faithfulness? Or will we break covenant with God?
