feeling for “more.” That “more” is Jesus Christ and His Divine Life!

We are built for that “more,” our DNA is prescribed for that “more;” our brains and our hearts are attuned for that “more”—*God*. Do you have a passion for “That”—or do you ration your passion =ie., I'll get to “That” -His Passion, later?

A Way to get in touch with “That more,” is Passion Week and Christ's Sacrifice: we learn, re-enact, re-present His Passion to tap into His Sacrifice, we undergo it = the Giving All! We too, disciples, must give all—& we learn by example and *participation*—actually “getting into the action”. Don't ration (minimalize) the Passion;. Don't just “think about it”—in the head. The Catholic Church gives you this great gift: Passion Week to *participate IN* ! So this Week give time in prayer (give of your very self, totally!); attend services, read the Bible accounts—get into them; fast (actually get hungry) and alms-give (the pain of letting go of money and clothes and food to others)--thus giving All of yourself, and making efforts like the Master, to learn to *be in His Mind*, giving All.

When you make a *confession* this week (see schedule above) you empty out sinfulness and fill up with grace—His Life, His All. So: Don't ration the Passion! Pray and repeat all Holy Week: *Your ruby droplets of Blood/ heal and free me Above...* He didn't ration, will you?
