

GUIDANCE NOTES FOR TIME TO LIVE FUND

ELIGIBILY CRITERIA

This fund is available to unpaid Carers. An unpaid Carer is someone who looks after and cares for a relative or friend with a disability or illness.

You must be doing a significant amount of caring for an adult. For example, full time caring or on a daily basis for several hours.

Priority will be given to Carers:

- Who do not have other family members to help them.
- Who do not have any other form of respite care.
- Who have health and well being problems.

On submission of your application form you will be contacted to acknowledge receipt of the form.

The application will go before a panel and a decision made.

You will be informed of the panel's decision.

If you are successful you will be told of the amount you will be allocated for your break.

You can then decide which type of break you prefer.

Our staff can help you make a decision and access the break if required.

We can also help you to get respite care for your dependant if required.
