Cheesecake Pumpkin Pie

1 (9 inch) graham cracker crust or regular pie crust

2 – 8 oz pkgs cream cheese, softened

1/2 cup white sugar 1/2 tsp vanilla extract

2 eggs

1/2 cup pumpkin puree 1 pinch ground cloves

1/2 tsp ground cinnamon 1 pinch ground nutmeg Preheat oven to 325 degrees. In a large bowl, combine cream cheese, sugar and vanilla. Beat until smooth. Blend in eggs one at a time. Remove 1 cup of batter and spread into bottom of crust. Set aside.

Add pumpkin, cinnamon, cloves + nutmeg to the remaining batter & stir gently until well blended. Carefully spread over the batter in the crust.

Bake in preheated oven 35-40 minutes, or until center is almost set. Allow to cool, then refrigerate for 3 hours or overnight. Top with whipped cream if desired.
