1. ANNOUNCEMENT:

The Hunter Motorcycle Club inc, hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct 2021 NSW Junior Dirt Track Championships for Dirt Track Junior Solo's and Support classes in 50cc Demonstration Solo's & Junior Speedway Solo's at the Barleigh Ranch Raceway 7 Barleigh Ranch Way Eagleton NSW on Saturday 14th and Sunday 15th August 2021.

2. JURISDICTION:

2.1. The above-mentioned open meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling NSW Limited who has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number INSERT PERMIT NUMBER and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia National Competition Licences

2.2. No Day licences accepted.

2.3. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, the By-Laws of Motorcycling NSW and any final instructions.

BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.

3. ENTRIES:

3.1. Entries open forthwith and close 6th August 2021

Only entries received online at www.racesecretary.com

3.2. In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the promoter, if such retention is approved by Motorcycling NSW.

3.3. Only entries received on the official online form that are accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.

3.4. **NOTE: LATE ENTRIES MAY BE ACCEPTED OR REJECTED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE RACE SECRETARY, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE RACE COMMITTEE OR CLUB EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE, AND THE RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE PROMOTER.**

4. INSURANCE:

4.1 National Capital Benefits Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.

4.2 Personal Accident and Ambulance Insurance is the responsibility of the individual.

4.3 **IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE DUE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT SUCH INSURANCE COVER.**

5. MEDICAL SERVICES:

INTERCEPT MEDICAL SERVICES will be in attendance from 9.00am until the completion of racing on both Saturday and Sunday.

8. CLASSES OF COMPETITION:

Championship Classes:

8.1 50cc Auto 7 to under 9 years

8.2 65cc 7 to under 9 years

8.3 65cc 9 to under 13 years

8.4 85cc 2-stroke & 150cc 4-stroke 9 to under 13 years

8.5 85cc 2-stroke & 150cc 4-stroke 12 to under 16 years

8.6 85cc 2-stroke & 150cc 4-stroke Junior Girls - 11 to under 16 years

8.7 85cc 4-stroke Modified - 7 to under 12 years.

8.8 100cc 2 -stroke to 150cc 2-stroke - 13 to under 16 years

8.9 200cc to 250cc 4-stroke - 13 to under 16 years

8.10 ATV 7 to u11 60cc Limited 60cc to 90cc s stk & 85cc to 110cc 4 stk

8.12 ATV 9 to u13 Comp 60 cc to 90cc s stk & 85cc to 125cc 4 stk

9. AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY:

All championship classes Trophies for 1st – 2nd- 3rd

Demonstration riders will all receive an award of the same or equal value.

10. ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

To constitute a class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be 10 or more starters for solo classes which actually participate in practice, qualifying or races and for Girls classes it will be 6 which actually participate in practice, qualifying or races.

10.1 Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards, will be at the discretion of the promoter, subject to Motorcycling NSW approval.

11. RACE FORMAT:

- 11.1 All competitors shall be given one (1) practice session of a minimum of two (2) laps.
- 11.2 Where there are twelve (12) or less Solo entries per class the championship comprises five (5) races of four (4) laps. Points accumulated by each competitor in the 5 races will determine Championship placings. This will also include the support classes.
- 11.3 Where there are more than twelve (12) Solo competitors entered and competing in a class the championship shall comprise of:
- a) Four (4) qualifying heats of three (3) laps.
 - b) One (1) race repechage of four (4) laps; and
 - c) One (1) final comprising of four (4) laps.
- 11.4 The repechage will be contested by competitors who finish 11th to 22nd inclusive during the course of the heats.
- 11.5 The right to compete in the final will be filled by: -
- a) The ten (10) competitors accumulating the highest number of points during the course of heats.
 - b) The first two (2) placing of the repechage. The finishing order of each competitor in the final will determine championship placings. Grid positions as per points choose first.
- 11.10 All races will be scored using the scoring system as per GCRs Chapter 14.10.11.1 – Scoring.
- 11.11 Speedway classes: where there are more than 4 riders will be run over 4 heats and a final. Final being comprised of the 4 top point scores from the heats. If less, then 4 run over 5 heats Points as per the GCR's 13.10.18.1

12. MACHINES AND RIDERS:

- 12.1 All machines entered must comply with the current GCR's for Dirt Track and Speedway competition.
- 12.2 Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class of competition is not permitted.
- 12.3 There will be no change of machines once the competition has commenced.
- 12.4 Noise &/or Fuel Testing may be carried out at any time during this meeting.

13. RIDING NUMBERS:

- 13.1 Competitors will be allocated their Motorcycling NSW Registered Riding Number or their preferred riding number if available. All others shall be allocated numbers at the Hunter Motorcycle Club inc discretion.
- 13.2 All number plates on all machines MUST comply with the GCR's.
- 13.3 Speedway will use helmet colours as per GCR's.

14. GRID POSITIONS:

Grid positions will be pre drawn and printed in the program, and if found to move from this assigned position will be excluded from that race.

Grid positions for the repechages/finals will be chosen by the highest point scorer having first choice & so on

15. RIDERS BRIEFING:

A Riders' Briefing will be held prior to the commencement of practice and ALL competitors MUST attend. Riders' Briefing sign-on sheets must be signed by the competitor as confirmation of attendance.

16. DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

By order of Motorcycling NSW, random drug &/or alcohol testing of participants (i.e., officials, competitors, mechanics, pit crew and any other person associated with the control, direction and operation of the competition) may take place prior to, or at any time during this meeting.

17. CODE OF CONDUCT:

All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCR's) which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this meeting and shall be enforced.

For the purposes of drug & alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be 7.30am with the completion of the meeting for the participant being at the completion of racing.

19. CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:

*The Dirt Track is approximately 650 metres in length; the surface is graded and rolled Rhyolite.
 Racing will be in an anti-clockwise direction. Speedway Track 125cc 120 metres/ 250cc 320 metres in length.*

20. STARTS:

*All starts will be from a drop forward gate with a maximum of 12 Solos. Start lights will be used. A red light will illuminate 10 seconds before the start, followed by a green light meaning the gates will release within 5 seconds.
 Speedway racers will be started by lights.*

21. RACING:

All riders will be given 2 laps practice per bike.
 All heats will be over 3 laps.
 All repechages will be over 4 laps.
 All FINALS will be over 4 Laps.
 All Demonstration Div 1 races will be held on the 300-metre track inside the main track and will be held over 5laps.

22. NOISE:

All machines must comply with the requirements of the GCR's and the track licence.

23. PAYG WITHOUT HOLDING: N.A

24. SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:

- 24.1 Presentation: The presentation will take place near the start tower as soon as possible after the final race.
- 24.2 Facilities: Canteen facilities will be available from 8.00am on Sat and Sun. Toilet facilities are septic system.
- 24.3 Tyres: Knobbly tyres are not allowed on any machine over 85/150cc.
- 24.4 Admission charges: There will be a \$10 charge per vehicle on Sunday ONLY.
- 24.5 Off Limits: The Score tower is OFF limits with the exception of the OFFICIALS of the meeting.
- 24.6 Marshals: A roster for corner Marshals will be drawn up and printed in the program.
- 24.7 NO ANIMALS are allowed in this complex with the exception of guide dogs.
- 24.8 PIT AREA: NO children under the age of 16 are allowed in the pit/paddock area unless they are a competitor.
 ALL persons entering the pit /paddock area must be wearing enclosed footwear.
- 24.9 ALL competitors are reminded of the requirement of a Catch Tray or Mat must be under your machine whilst in the Pit/Paddock area
