- Please respect our instructions of one family through the gate at a time in line with the social distancing protocols in place.
- Our QR code is on the gate and the sign on table for you to check in when you drop off and collect your children according to Government guidelines
- Please wear a mask when dropping off and picking up your children.
- If there is no staff member at the door, please ring BASC's phone and we will send your child out to you as soon as possible.
- Staff at BASC are wearing masks in all indoor and outdoor areas.
