Unauthorized Tree Removal

Paulin's Lane Garage in ROW

The variance was to be 2 feet from the road ROW, but the garage is almost entirely in the ROW. They are going to have it surveyed to find out where the road ROW really is. Then they need to determine how much property they are going to have to take from us so that they are 2 feet back from the road ROW. Then they are going to have it recorded and maintain a turnaround somewhere for us to turn around.

Culvert on Shamrock Lane

We received a complaint about the water running off the field on the off lake side of the road, running through the culvert, through his yard, over his drain field filling up his septic tank, ultimately ending up in the lake causing weeds to grow in the lake. They are saying that the township signed some agreement with the land owner that they would put up a barricade their or keep it seeded down in a cover crop. This agreement was supposedly made in the 2004 to 2006 time frame.

Dog at Humane Society

Someone dropped a dog off at the end of someone's driveway in a kennel. Then we were called to see if we would pay the impound fee. We'll check to see what other townships do. Do they pay all cat and dog impound fees?
