## WESTERN DISTRICT SCHOLARSHIP REPORT MAY 5, 2018

Dear Western District Arcadians,

It has been my honor and privilege to be the 2017-2018 Western District Scholarship Chairman. The scholarship guidelines, information, and applications were distributed to all chapters. They were also posted on the Western District website.

By May 16, 2018, the submission deadline, six (6) completed applications were received.
