From the Pastor's Desk

Dear brothers and sisters,

Today I want to speak about two events that are going to happen in the coming week. First, we are celebrating this Sunday the solemnity of Christ King of the Universe and at the same time Pope Francis has moved to this Sunday the local yearly Youth Day. Second, we are going to celebrate Thanksgiving next Thursday. Let me start by the later, we are celebrating a day in which we are all invited to give thanks for all the graces and gifts received this year. I think this is very important because we can easily get stuck on what we want and do not have instead of rejoicing and enjoying what God knows we need and gives to us. I hope this year, you can gather around a table with family and friends and express what are you thankful for. Coming back to the solemnity of Christ the King, this feast was instituted in the middle of dispute between the government in Italy and the Holy See before there was the Lateran Treaties that defined the relationship between the two. The Pope was told not to speak, and that government was the last word. To this, the Church responded that Jesus Christ is the true Lord/King of the Universe and only God's truth is absolute. For this reason, the Church is always on a higher moral ground that any government, the Church speaks the truth of Christ Risen and brings this Good News to all. No political party nor person can give you what your heart seeks only God – our hearts are restless until they rest in you (St. Augustine). Finally, we all were very surprised how well our Youth Group Core Team participated in our Friendsgiving. Last Sunday three members received awards at the Cathedral, and I am happy that a space is being created for the Youth. I wanted to let you know that we are getting parishioners trained to help me do the work we will have to do for the Synod that Pope Francis has asked us for. It will be a wonderful opportunity to discern what the Holy Spirit is calling us for. Pray for me that I pray for you.

Hoy quiero hablar sobre dos eventos que van a suceder la semana que viene. En primer lugar, este domingo celebramos la solemnidad de Cristo Rey del Universo y, al mismo tiempo, el Papa Francisco ha trasladado a este domingo la Jornada anual de la juventud local. En segundo lugar, vamos a celebrar el Día de Acción de Gracias el próximo jueves. Permítanme comenzar por la última, estamos celebrando un día en el que todos estamos invitados a dar gracias por todas las gracias y dones recibidos este año. Por esta razón, la Iglesia está siempre en una base moral más alta que cualquier gobierno, la Iglesia habla la verdad de Cristo Resucitado y trae esta Buena Nueva a todos. Ningún partido político ni persona puede darte lo que tu corazón busca solo Dios - nuestro corazón está inquieto hasta que descansa en ti (San Agustín). Finalmente, todos quedamos muy sorprendidos de lo bien que participó nuestro Equipo Central del Grupo Juvenil en nuestro Día de Acción de Amigos. El pasado domingo tres socios recibieron premios en la Catedral, y me alegro de que se esté creando un espacio para la Juventud.

Quería hacerles saber que estamos capacitando a los feligreses para que me ayuden a hacer el trabajo que tendremos que hacer para el Sínodo que el Papa Francisco nos ha pedido. 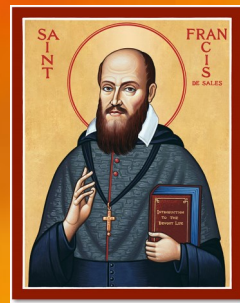
