Terms & Condition of application

The Wedding Wishing Well Foundation supports applications for same sex marriages; divorcees but they do not condone applications from incestuous relationships due to this being illegal.

We also do not discriminate against religions or race. The Wedding Wishing Well Foundation may not be able to cover the whole of your wedding but we will discuss this with you after we receive your application.

We will try to fund all or part of your wedding, however we will help with all the organising of your special day.

We cannot also full fill the wishes of every single application we receive. We will meet with a board that will discuss a group of applicants and decide who we can help with the team, budget and contacts we have. Sadly our budget isn't end less!

Many of the items used at the wedding will remain our property. Items that you are able to keep you will be made aware of. Anything you wish to keep can be purchased from us. Items that are damaged by guests attending your wedding, will be charged to the Bride and Groom at the rates set by the supplier.

The Wedding Wishing Well Foundation will not be held accountable for any damages that were not their fault. Where theft of items of damages occur the bride & groom will be charged by the charity for them with no acceptations.

To apply for help from The Wedding Wishing Well Foundation you must meet the following criteria and to allow us to speak with health care professionals involved in your care. We do not give donations of money to people planning their own weddings.

For your application to be valid you must be able to answer YES to the following 3 questions:

- We are both free to marry.
- We are in receipt of a means tested benefit I live in mainland England, or Wales.
- One or both of us have a terminal or life limiting illness.
