March is a busy month for the Post as we start to gear our activities back up. Here is the rundown of what is coming and flyers will be posted for the various events around the Post:

- 4 March: The kitchen reopens for Friday night dinners..yeah!!!
- 15 March: This date is the official birthday of The American Legion which was established in 1919.

- 26 March: The Post will have a table set up at the Lake West Business Expo and are looking for volunteers to man the table in shifts throughout the day.

March is also the month the United States entered into combat operations in Operation Iraqi Freedom. 20 March 2003 marked the beginning of the conflict with preemptive airstrikes on Saddam Hussein's Presidential Palace and military targets followed by approximately 67,700 "boots on the ground", 15,000 Navy personnel on ships in the combat theater, and 24,000 combat sorties from the Air Force. After nine years of conflict, the war was officially declared over on 15 December 2011. At final roll call, the Nation had lost 4,431 military personnel Killed In Action and 31,994 additional Wounded In Action. Of those numbers, 43 men and women from Missouri sacrificed their lives for their buddies who stood with them and for their Nation. They came from small towns and big cities...farms and factories...may we never forget them and the sacrifice they made for our Freedom!!!

From the officers and staff of Post 624, have a great March!! And for those Snowbirds listening, Spring is coming to the Ozarks so please come home!!!
