- *Leave stems as long as possible. They can be cut to size after being entered.*
- *Judging is on perfection of flower, straightness, freshness and freedom from insect infestation.*
- *Containers supplied by Steward, unless otherwise specified.*
- *Roses - leave some foliage on but no buds.*
- *Stem - can have one or more multiple flowers*
