# BYLAWS MAZAMA COMMUNITY CLUB (a nonprofit corporation) Amended November 8, 2014

### I OFFICERS

- 1. The offices of the Club shall consist of a President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer who shall be elected annually.
- 2. Officers shall be elected by a majority of all votes cast in the election.
- 3. The President shall preside over all meetings of the Club and exercise all powers usually incident to such office. In the absence of the President from any meeting, the Vice-President shall perform all duties incumbent upon the President.
- 4. The Treasurer shall pay all bills properly presented to her/him, and shall receive a receipt for each bill paid or state upon the check for what the amount was paid, and shall keep the financial books and records of the corporation.
- 5. The Secretary shall keep minutes of all meetings of the corporation and shall exercise such other powers as are usually incident to such office.

# II DIRECTORS

- 1. The Board of Directors shall consist of between five and fifteen directors.
- 2. Each director shall be elected for a term of three years and until his/her successor has been elected. Terms of the directors shall be staggered, so that at least one new director shall be elected each year. A vacancy on the board may be filled by a majority vote of the directors or by a majority of club members at the annual meeting.

- 3. The directors shall conduct the business of the corporation and shall direct the officers and shall make such decisions and exercise such authorities and duties as are set forth in the Articles of Incorporation, these Bylaws, or the laws of the State of Washington.
- 4. Any director may be removed from office by a two-thirds vote of the membership at any regular or special meeting of the membership. Notice of the removal of a director must be given to such director prior to the date of the meeting at which such removal is to be voted upon. Such notice to the director must state the cause for the proposed removal.

## III MEETINGS

- 1. A regular business and social meeting of the membership, officers and directors of the Club shall be held annually at the Mazama Community Club building.
- 2. Special meetings may be called from time to time by any officer. Two weeks' notice should be given by publication in the local newspaper or electronically.

# IV MEMBERSHIP

1. All who pay the annual membership dues are full members of the Club and are entitled to one vote per member. Membership dues are due in March of each year for the following year.

# V CLUB BUILDING

- 1. Arrangements for use of the building shall be made with the Reservations Officer. The board of directors shall set limits on rentals.
- 2. There shall be no donation required for any function co-sponsored by the Club.

3. No minors may rent the Club building, and an adult shall be present at all functions.

These bylaws may be amended by a majority vote of the membership present and voting at a regular or special meeting. Two weeks' written notice shall be given electronically or by publication in the local newspaper of any proposed changes in the bylaws.
