**RED FOR PENTECOST:** May 23rd is the Day of Pentecost, in which we celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit as it is given to the church. In celebration, we invite you to bring red flowers to decorate the sanctuary, and then which may be planted on the church grounds later in the week. Additionally, you are encouraged to wear red to church.
