Two New Charity grants from St. Joseph Church: St. Joseph Church has just granted \$50,000.00 to The Atrium Village in Hills that will go to the replacement of their heating system. St. Joseph Church has also just granted \$5,000.00 to Father Bill Kneemiller's Holy Land Military Rosary and their rosary factory in Haiti.

The St. Joseph Charity Fund in addition to the above listed \$55,000.00 grants also awarded \$105,000.00 in Christmas grants that were recognized in our January 10 bulletin for this past Fiscal Year for a total of \$160,000.00 in grants. St. Joseph sets aside \$1,000.00 each month for our Helping Hands Project, plus the third Sunday Helping Hands basket at the altar so far this Fiscal Year has totaled \$12,800.00 which includes \$5,780.00 in rental assistance, \$126.50 for bus tickets, \$300.00 for lodging, \$892.00 in car repairs, \$110.00 in food assistance, \$220.00 in gas cards, \$293.90 in water bills, \$1,036.43 for utility bills, \$300.00 for childrens' Christmas presents, \$300.00 for fire emergency. The total for Helping Hands assistance as of 6-16-2021 for this fiscal year is \$12,736.83.
