Ministry Notes

Next month I'll have been in ministry for fifteen years. I have a lot of memories of being with families as their loved ones passed away. Memories of visiting people in the hospital or nursing homes. Memories of bible studies, worship services, fellowship...

If there's anything I've learned in fifteen years—it's to show up! Being present with people is the most important thing there is... You don't need to have all the answers; you just need to be there.

When I was doing my Chaplaincy training, my supervisor had us read a research paper examining the length of stays of hospital patients who had suffered a heart attack. Specifically comparing patients who received regular visits from a Chaplain, and patients who received regular visits from a therapy dog.

Guess which group had the shorter hospital stays? Yup, it was the patients that received visits from the dogs! My supervisor said, "You need to learn to be like a dog-- don't judge, don't talk, just look at the patients with big eyes and wag your tail." Of course, we all thought that it was pretty funny, but there was also a lot of truth to it.

Presence communicates love and care. Presence communicates connection and solidarity. Presence communicates compassion. Our physical presence is often the very heart beat that gives each other hope.

This is why family gatherings on Holidays are so important. It's how we express our love for one another. And it's also why this social distancing has been so hard! We want so desperately to hug one another and be in each other's space! But, we can't. I get it, I want nothing else in the whole world than to hug my kids.

I think we're all a little "presence" deprived.

The good news of Christmas is that God came to be present with us! Jesus was born into this world to show us how much He loves us!

I wonder, do you suppose that during this pandemic, we might experience the meaning of that in a deeper way than before? Do you suppose we might actually be able to feel the heartbeat of God in our own chest?

Imagine with me... Close your eyes and take some deep breaths... Feel your lungs expand and contract. Focus on your heart beat. Can you feel it? That pulse you feel is the rhythm of God... That pulse you feel is God telling you that you are His special creation. That pulse you feel is God wrapping His arms around you in love and forgiveness. A real, live, physical presence...

God is present all around you. God loves you. And God will be with us through this Christmas season and far beyond. And thanks be to God...

Merry Christmas, everyone. And may God bless us all, in unique and surprising ways.


