-John Miller Towns have some responsibility to provide the sheriffs department with what they need to keep safety on the lakes.

-Caroline Murphy asked how many times they have patrolled Stratton Lake and Spencer Lake in the Town of Dayton?

-Dan Lewinski said they try to get to all lakes that have boat access on opening day of fishing and when there are specific complaints. Staffing has been an issue in the past.

-Caroline Murphy said the previous statement just reiterated the importance of this agreement. So that we can have more say as to when they need to be on the lakes.

-Craig Nelson said that the boats need to be on site and we need to keep the agreement.

-Mark Jensen agrees it is important to have our own agreement.

-A motion by Jim Peglow to approve the agreement seconded by Mark Jensen. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.
