

Riding Arena Etiquette

Good arena etiquette is more than just manners—it helps keep horses and riders safe. Here are some basic guidelines:

Keep right, so that oncoming horses pass you left-shoulder to left-shoulder. This rule helps prevent collisions and confusion.

Match your speed to the traffic flow. If slower riders are sticking to an inside track while faster ones are working closer to the rail, respect and follow that pattern.

Do not tailgate. Leave at least eight to 10 feet between you and the horse ahead of you. If your horse is known to kick, tie a red ribbon to the base of his tail to let other riders know they need to leave plenty of extra room when passing you.

Call out your moves. You don't want to catch anyone by surprise when you're passing them at speed. A polite "heads up on the inside" or "outside oxer line" will notify others of your intentions, especially if they don't see you approach.

Be patient. When accidental cut-offs or traffic jams occur, remember to be courteous and forgiving.
