Actions Update + Matters Arising

Sign for the blind corner at Kanuka Road – Peter

- Request lodged, reply received AKL Transport – who won't action as not aware of logged incidents for the location. Closed.

Benches on walking tracks - David

- Scoping and siting for new benches wip - no progress during lockdown

Bus shelter for school children - Peter

- Continued to follow up with Total Span Bruce = local TS Rep will provide one at cost
- Peter to confirm with Ross ref willingness to do earthworks
- Progress as possible due to Covid

Horse Shoe Bay track - David

- WIP - due to weather work can't be progressed til Nov – update Committee closer to that time

Brick Bay Tobacco weed infestation - Peter

- Work in progress - emailed owner of invested property who declined support

Creek St Walkway – Greg D

- Greg and Gary to write up proposal to Council to formalize development of paper road to a walking & cycling track
- Next steps and timing TBC

Co-ord Predator Plan - Steve

- WIP Steve to meet with David when he's available to draw up plan for Oct/Nov implementation
- Rat Control
 - Free rat bait being used currently has a potential environmental risk; cumulative damage through the food chain + waterway contamination. Steve to email Beth with contamination issue background so she can follow up with
 - Tablets and blocks are out of stock currently with Covid supply chain issues = potential for rat population explosion aligned with spring nestling season
 - Could replace by moving to physical kill traps made by Men's Shed. Will have a cost and require daily attention to manage and clear so not ideal.
 - Potentially medium term could be funded / alternative provided through RRE group

- Greg & Jo updated Committee on the RRE steering group committee meeting they attended via Zoom on 6 September

- Weed issue Sandspit Road from Kanuka Rd to Greens Point Arundo Grass + Jasmine + Wattle + Moth plant + yellow flowered, privet, tobacco weed, gorse, morning glory
 - (Enthusiastic) working team looking at tackling Sandspit Road Arundo grass issue planning 4-5 month knock back followed by replacement native planting programme
 - Steve tabled Health and Safety plan for working bee Chair reiterated necessity of having a safety first approach.
 - Discussion as to whether this specific issue should be actioned by Council in the first instance, Council were notified of the issue 2 years ago but haven't actioned
 - **Beth** to contact her relationship manager at Council Environmental Services to seek action prior to SRRA Landcare groups taking action
