

Iowa Intensity 2016 Fall Classic Basketball Tournament Rules

- Players can only be listed on 1 roster in an age division. The tournament is designed for girls 5th through 8th grade and boys in 5th through 8th grade.
- 3 games scheduled guarantee, not responsible if another team forfeits.
- Games on November 18 to 19, deadline of entry is November 12. Schedule will be sent out on November 14, 5 PM or before.
- Only 5th & 6th grade could play on the 18th, will attempt to play as many games on Saturday as possible.
- Limited to the first 8 teams that enter with payment from each division.
- Cost is \$160 per team
- Games will be played at Grinnell, Iowa area gyms.
- Players should bring their own warm-up balls.
- A 28.5" basketball will be used in all games for girls and boys.
- Each team will need to provide one adult scorekeeper/clock operator for their games.
- (2) 18-minute halves.
- Continuous clock until the last 2 minutes of the 2nd half, unless there is a lead of greater than 15 points, in which case the clock will continue to run.
- Mercy rule - game will be over if a team is up 20 points with 2 minutes or less left.
- 3 - 1 minute time outs per game. Clock stops during all time outs (can only carry over 2 time outs for the 2nd half).
- Overtime - 2 minutes (clock will stop). If second overtime is played, the game will be sudden death (first team to score wins).
- 1 time out per team in the first overtime only.
- 3 to 5 minutes for halftime depending upon whether we are running ahead or behind schedule.
- Start next game 3 to 5 minutes after the previous game is complete, up to 15 minutes early if running ahead of schedule.
- 3-point shots are scored as such.
- Full Court Press and Zone is allowed at any time during the game, UNLESS team is ahead by 15 or more points in the second half (otherwise half-court man-to-man required).
- Uniforms with numbers on *front and back* required; preferably light and dark color jerseys. Team listed first on the schedule is home and should wear a light colored jersey.
- Coaches will be allowed to stand only to motivate and coach the players in a positive manner. If an official asks a coach to sit down, the coach must comply. Failure to do so will result in an immediate technical foul.
- Technical Fouls:
 - The following policy will be used regarding Technical Fouls for all Coaches and Players:
 - First Technical = Warning
 - Second Technical = Immediate removal from the game
 - Third Technical = Individual will be banned for the remainder of the league season

- All rules not covered here will follow the Iowa High School Athletic Association.
- \$6 adult admission and \$3 child (less than 18) admission for the weekend will be collected for each non-player entering, two coaches also are admitted free (5 years old and younger are free).
- Spectators: No food or beverage may be brought into the gym with the exception of one water bottle or sports drink per playing participant. Clean-up the team bench area after the game.
- A small concession stand will be available.
- Tournament director has final decision on all disputes and situations.
