

## **Greater Module 3:** Digging Ditches

This Session's Key Idea: We can start small as we seek a greater life, but we need to make practical preparations that demonstrate our faith

## **Questions:**

- 1) Read 2 Kings 3:9-20, the story of Elisha coming to the rescue of three kings and their thirsty army
- 2) What would look different if you approached your part and God's part in bringing about a greater life not as either/or but as both/and?
- 3) What ditches is God calling you to dig? If you're not sure, what might help you figure it out? What's the very first small step you need to take toward your greater future?
- 4) What kinds of new blessings do you think God wants you to make room for in your life?

## **My Action Step:**

Even though God told the army of the three kings to make the valley full of ditches, He sent the water the next day--that is, at a time when they'd just gotten started on the task. In other words, He blessed them immediately after they started small. This goes to show that the simple act of taking a step can be enough to cause God to act in your life.
