Feast Shavuot



<u>Shavuot workbook</u> (For 3–6 years old)

We have been counting 50 days or 7 weeks, since First fruit, in order to know when it is Shavuot. Now we are here. Shavuot is the third Holy feast of Yahweh. It can also be called First Fruits, Pentacost or the Feast of weeks. On this special day we do no work and we come together with Yahweh's people, like a Shabbat meeting.

In the old covenant the people, Israelites, would bake two loaves of bread with leavening to present it to the priest on this day. They would use the grain that the took as first fruit offering, 50 days earlier.

In the new covenant Yahshua had Yahweh's Spirit and He was the First of the first fruit to Yahweh. Yahshua promised His disciples a Helper. So, on the day of Shavuot, Yahweh gave the Holy Spirit to the disciples to strengthen them as first fruit to do His work.
