### How Much Does It Cost?

Cost of the weekend is \$165.00 if the application and fee is received by Sept 6, 2019. Applications received after this date require a \$25.00 registration fee, with the balance of \$165.00 due before or upon arrival at the camp. This fee covers all charges for lodging and meals. You won't need any additional money for the weekend. Scholarship funds are available.
