



## What Happens at Cursillo?

The Cursillo weekend is a three-day faith renewal event filled with worship, singing, study, and lots of fun activities. The experience is designed to be enjoyable, thought-provoking, welcoming, faith-building, and relational.

Discussions are centered around a series of 15 talks by both lay people and clergy on the themes of God’s grace, the practices of Christian discipleship, and what it means to be the church. The weekend is wrapped in prayer, meditation, and daily Communion.

You will have the opportunity to listen and learn, to relax free from the distractions of the world, and to reflect upon your faith and relationship with God.

## What Happens After Cursillo?

Your weekend is only the beginning of your Cursillo experience! What you learn and share during the weekend is intended to be taken back and put into practice in your family, local congregation, and your community.

The Eastern Oklahoma Presbyterian Cursillo community is comprised of a few hundred members. You will be supported by many others who have previously attend a Cursillo weekend.

You will have the opportunity to meet in small renewal groups to support one another and to share the Christian life. There are also periodic gatherings (“Ultreyas”) which bring together the larger Cursillo community.

Many Cursillo participants have formed deep friendships within the Cursillo community. It has often been these friendships which have

sustained them through the difficult times of their lives.

## Is Cursillo a Substitute for my Church?

No. Cursillo is an on-going, world-wide spiritual renewal movement intended to strengthen the local church through the development of Christian disciples and leaders. Cursillo encourages purposeful living into the Kingdom of God in every environment in which a Christian resides.

The Cursillo viewpoint seriously considers the model of Jesus’ servanthood and how it instructs His followers to act in ways appropriate to being “a servant to all.”

Our Cursillo activities are sponsored under the auspices of the Eastern Oklahoma Presbytery. Our membership and activities are open to any member of a Presbyterian church.

Worldwide, more than 2 million people in over 50 nations have attended a Cursillo weekend.
