## **DAY FOR LIFE - "YOU CAN JUDGE A SOCIETY BY THE WAY IT CARES FOR IT WEAKEST MEMBERS"**

Today we celebrate *Day for Life 2021*. This day, inaugurated by Saint John Paul II (the quote above is from his address in St. George's Cathedral, Southwark on his Pastoral Visit to Britain in May 1982), presents an opportunity to pray for the gift of life from conception to natural death, to raise awareness of the precious gift of life, and to support the work of protecting life in its most vulnerable stages through the annual collection. This assists pro-life organisations who raise awareness, engage in parliamentary work and pastoral outreach. The fragility of life and the reality of death has been brought into sharp focus during the Covid-19 pandemic. So many people have died, yet in the face of such suffering and death we have witnessed the extraordinary dedication of healthcare professionals and their loving care for the sick and dying. These acts of heroic love are a powerful testimony to the fundamental dignity of the human person and to the respect owed to each life. Against this backdrop of loving care, we are now faced with the very real threat of legislation of 'assisted suicide' in our country. **In the future - how will Our Society TODAY be judged in regard to our CARE for it's Weakest?**

#### **Latest Guidance for Communal Worship during the COVID 19 Pandemic**

The final stage of the reopening from lockdown will be delayed by 4 weeks, over fears of a third wave of the virus caused by the Delta variant which is now said to be prevalent in England. The new opening day is 19<sup>th</sup> July, although this is not confirmed.

The key measures, which churches and parishes have been carrying out, are to remain in place.

**Hand sanitiser must continue to be used on entry to churches and before liturgies.**

Please either scan in on the NHS Track & Trace or tick your name off the register.

**Please take one of the sheets** provided which must be left on the bench where you have been sitting. This is to ensure all the appropriate areas in church get sanitised after every service.

**At all times please adhere to the rules of SOCIAL DISTANCING** – sitting 1m apart in the church pews and the wearing of **FACE MASKS**. Please ensure that face coverings are worn properly, covering the nose, to reduce aerosol or droplet spread.

**Offertory collection at Mass** There are baskets at the entrance and exit from the church. Where possible, please use the contactless donation system. Payments can be made from a Stand in the church porch.

**Physical exchange of a Sign of Peace** remains suspended.

**Holy Communion is given in the hand only.** Please wait in your pew until instructed to move forward. The communicant should have his/her arms outstretched to the full, palms facing upwards, one on top of the other. After unlooping the face covering the communicant consumes the Sacred Host at the sanctuary steps, replaces the face covering and moves back to the pew via one of the side aisles.
