- * **APPLY FOR SCHOOL (Oct/Nov)**
- * Retake the ACT if you want to improve your score (October-last test for many academic and scholarship opportunities)
- * **File a free application for student aid (FAFSA) beginning OCTOBER 1st for 2021-2022 school year**
- * Sign up for orientation at your school of choice (Oct-April)
- * Secure your housing (April/May)
- * Send your **final** HS transcripts to your college/school once you graduate (June)
