SCHOOL-BASED

COUNSELING SERVICES



Children often experience significant emotional or behavioral difficulties in the school and home settings.

We realize that many families have difficulty attending traditional outpatient counseling services in the community. That is why we are offering integrated school-based counseling services in your child's school.

Your child will receive person-centered outpatient counseling tailored to meet their needs. School-based services allow our clinicians and the school to communicate and effectively coordinate care for your child.

Families are also encouraged to participate and be a part of the treatment planning. An integrated approach is vital to your child's progress and success in the counseling process.

Let us provide a safe and supportive space to help your child discover, explore, and develop healthy ways to successfully navigate the social and emotional dynamics of childhood and adolescence.

OTHER SERVICES OFFERED

CHILD CASE MANAGEMENT

This service assists children and their families with accessing community resources and supports essential to meeting basic physical and mental health needs.

INTENSIVE CARE COORDINATION (ICC)

ICC utilizes the evidence-based High Fidelity Wraparound (HFW) model to help youth/adolescents at risk of an out-of-home placement and those who are transitioning back into the community after residential placement. HFW is a team-based, collaborative planning process for developing and implementing individualized care plans for children with behavioral health challenges and their families.

PSYCHIATRIC SERVICES

We offer psychiatric services and medication management for children, adolescents, and families.

INTELLECTUAL DISABILITIES

These services include case management, waiver application assistance, vocational training, and residential services.
