

Beta-Psi Re-Activation...In Progress!

All of our efforts since 2007 have had one primary goal...to bring Beta-Psi & TKE back to ASU! *TKE National submitted the Intent to Colonize application in late Oct!*

We have taken the time to learn from our successes & struggles, so that the Chapter we return will be what we all want! We are NOW at that time! IT IS OUR MOMENT!

We are fortunate to already have about 30 potential initiates to consider for membership as early as **Spring 2016!**

This hasn't happened overnight but it is happening right! We have a group of area Alumni set to go through volunteer training with TKE to serve as *Local Mentors* to these new members.

With this system of Local Mentors, these new initiates will receive "hands on" attention for training & organization skills especially during the first few years.

We have a Board of Directors spread across the nation to "work" our Alumni in recruiting.

TKE House Project UPDATE!



Do you recall the "glory days" of Delta Hall? Any fraternity NOT in Delta Hall was "behind in the game!"

To help our Re-Activated Chapter flourish, we will have to ultimately provide a TKE HOUSE IN the Greek Village among the other fraternities.

We have worked with construction & architecture groups to present this Concept House which illustrates our minimal needs yet within a modest budget of around \$750,000. For a commercial grade facility, the avg cost/sq ft is about \$150.

Initially, it will house 5-6 fraters but will be built to add rooms as inexpensive as possible when we grow & are financially suited. These images are initial concepts & the plan can be adapted when we get to the construction phase.

We NEED YOUR Help to Accomplish This!

Our First Stage is our Centurion Campaign:

We NEED 80-100 Fraters to reach \$100,000 by donating \$500 or \$1000 in this first year! All donors will have their name inscribed on a cornerstone plaque on the house! These donations can be made in lump sums or payments as you choose but we NEED this goal reached by 2016!

With the startup money we have, our pledges/donations to date, plus a few fraters making \$5,000 pledges, we are about 1/3 of the way there! Once we reach near 100 Fraters & \$100,000 THEN we will have the credibility to reach out to Fraters with the ability to make larger donations, even to sponsor an area in the House.

The Next Level will be our <u>Triangle Campaign</u>. With the larger donors' gifts, we will ask the Centurion Donors to step up a little more over the next few years & reach out to those who have not given. *This goal is to get to the \$350,000 level in 3 yrs, by 2019*, to realistically approach the construction phase.

We will not place a huge burden on the Chapter. By design, if we mortgage less than half the cost, the chapter will be able to sustain the financial obligation with minimal support by the AA.


