

Phone Companies Implement Robocall Blocking

Robocall relief is here. In 2017 the FCC set new rules that Telecommunication companies must implement Robocall blocking by June 2019. I recently checked with AT&T and Verizon and they both have this service available. The robocall blocking is for cell phones and land lines; local, domestic, international calls as well as text messages. AT&T has a service that's free and one that costs a \$3.99 per month. For AT&T it's called "**AT&T Call Protect**". The free service includes security features and call notification warnings about potential robocalls. The paid service provides actual call blocking. Services offered may not be inclusive of everything I mentioned above because it's a new service but go ahead and contact your provider and find out more. I was told by Verizon that they also have similar services.
