

The Board of Directors and the Property Manager have been working with Waste Management to alleviate the Garbage issue in Sonoma Bay. Garbage Toters will be given to all garage units provided the resident signs a release stating that they will abide by the Rules and

Regulations regarding the use of the Toter. Complete the form included in this newsletter and return it to Niambi Emanuel, Property Manager and you will receive a Toter with your address on it.

NON-GARAGE UNITS

The non-garage units cannot have a garbage can because there is nowhere to store it. The residents of the non-garage units will continue to use the dumpsters. Sonoma Bay is taking a "NO TOLERANCE" to those who not follow the following rules:

- 1. All trash must be put in garbage bags and tied closed to insure the contents remains in the bag. Put the garbage into the dumpsters. Garbage that falls out to the ground because resident did not secure the bag properly or leaves trash outside of the dumpsters will be charged a fee of 100.00 for cleanup.
- 2. Do not send children to take out the trash if they cannot lift the lid of the trash container or if they are not tall enough to get the trash bag inside of the dumpster.
- 3. Bulk pick up is every Thursday. If you have bulk items you wish to get rid of please call Waste Management at 561-547-4000. You will need to call by Tuesday morning to schedule a Thursday pick up. Just let them know the location of the dumpster you will be placing the items by. Do not put these items out until Wednesday night. Place items outside against the dumpster wall; do not block the front doors. Anyone placing Bulk trash out other than Wednesday will be fined \$100.

If you see trash on the ground, pick it up and properly dispose it in the dumpster.


AFTER SCHOOL READING PROGRAM

Pet Care!

The Board of Directors wants to stress the above concerns to Sonoma Bay residents again. All residents have attended the Orientation before move in and lease renewals. It is very imperative that the Rules & Regulations of the Community are followed especially the Pet Rules.

- 1. All pets must be approved by the Association! No aggressive breeds or pets that weight over 35lbs at maturity.
- 2. Dogs Must be kept on a leash at all times when walking the grounds of Sonoma Bay.

3. Your Pet may eliminate waste either near the Pet Waste Station or directly behind your unit. The waste must be picked up immediately and disposed of properly.

If you cannot follow the Pet Rules, fines will be assessed to the owner of the property for each violation! The violation will be determined by the Fining Committee but no less than \$100 per occurrence. The Palm Beach Count fine is no less than \$250 per occurrence

Exterior Antennas

NO exterior antennas, satellite dishes (Direct TV) or similar equipment shall be permitted in Sonoma Bay. All resident must use Hotwire Communications. Hotwire Communications is your cable/internet/phone service provider. You may reach their customer service at (855) 244-1051.

Disclosure: Residents who currently have Satellite dishes will be able to continue with their prospective companies. Any resident who moves out of the community or to another address within the community will have the satellite dish removed.

Bar Code Deactivation

All bar codes to a particular address that is in violation of the Rules & Regulations of the Community will have their bar codes deactivated until the issue is resolved.

Tenants whose lease has not been renewed by the HOA must vacate the property within 30 days of the letter

Shutters

OCCUPIED UNITS cannot have shutters up except during a hurricane. All units must have access to the outside in case of emergency. Anyone receiving a violation warning must remove the shutters within 3 days. If not removed, you will receive a second notice informing the owner that at the next fining committee meeting, they will be charged \$100 per day up to \$1,000.

Please do not put your family at risk. Safety comes first!
