
WHY CHRISTIAN CAMP?

Summertime! The arrival of summer was a bigger deal to me as a kid than even Christmas. I loved the break from schoolwork, the chance to spend the days playing basketball, making some money from neighborhood yardwork, playing in the creeks, riding bikes, and a hundred other things. The opportunities abounded. But from the age of ten, the number one thing I loved about summer was going to Christian camp.

Kids today have many opportunities for sports camps, band camps, scouts, etc., that are all valuable. But I would encourage parents and students to make Christian Youth Camp a priority. If Christian faith and spiritual formation are important to you, and I argue that they are the most important training a young person can receive, then Christian youth camp is the only place that focuses all of their efforts on that goal. Beyond all of the Sunday School, VBS, and youth group gatherings, the transformative impact of a week away from the noise and distractions of our modern life is impossible to calculate. For many young people, camp will be their best opportunity to consider a decision to follow Christ, and what that means in daily living. The support system of lifelong friends made at camp brings an accountability and loving network to help maneuver the pitfalls of adolescence. *Start children off on the way they should go, and even when they are old they will not turn from it. • Cost is \$151.20 per person inclusive


* Each group is able to chose which additional Adventure they would like to do. * Here are things students would need to bring with them since we would be staying in cabins:

WHAT IS PENNY CRUSADE

In 1956, Chester Randall made an unusual donation of 4,175 pennies to help Advent Christians spread the gospel to the nations. This served as an inspiration and launch pad for a yearly denominational fundraising effort called Penny Crusade. Since then, more than 16 million dollars has been raised and sent by more than 300 AC churches.

WHERE DOES THE MONEY GO

Advent Christian ministry partnerships now exist in more than 20 countries. Indian pastors, Filipino missionaries, African pastors, children's homes, a Bible college, discipleship groups, feeding ministries, training events and new church plants are all strengthened by money raised through Penny Crusade. 100% of Penny Crusade dollars goes to missions.
