We represented our members before the state legislature by:

- Stopping a bill that would have required pre-notification before applying pesticides and use reporting afterward.
- Preventing a surtax on pesticides and petroleum products.
- Stopping a new capital gains tax.

We developed educational materials for members about:

- EPA's Worker Protection Standard
- Forest herbicide Frequently Asked Questions
- Forest herbicide Best Management Practices
- Forest herbicide community outreach

We supported our members by:

- Hosting four member training sessions to help members gain skills in talking about pesticides.
- Hosting an All Agency Pest/Pesticide
 Issues Forum to encourage agencies to
 share information with each other and
 allow our members to learn more about
 agency programs and plans.
- Providing feedback to DNR about materials they developed relating to herbicide use in forestry.
- Working with WFPA to relaunch community outreach.
- Supporting county weed boards in several counties where citizens had expressed concern about herbicide use.
- Working with the Washington Policy Center's new ag bureau.
- Working with the Food Policy Forum to ensure they had access to accurate information about production agriculture.
