Definition A visual poetry composed exclusively for the page in which a picture or image is made of printed letters and words.

Concrete poetry attempts to blur the line between language and visual objects, usually relying on puns and cleverness. Term Abstract Diction. Definition Words that express general ideas or concepts. Term Allusion. Definition indirect reference to any person, place or thing... fictitious, historical or actual. Acts as a literary short hand.

Term Apostrophe. Definition a way of addressing someone or something invisible or not ordinarily spoken to. Term Colloquial English. Definition The casual conversation or informal writing of literate people. Term Concrete Diction. Definition what we can immediately perceive with our senses dog, chemical, actor, etc. Term Connotation. Definition overtones or suggestions of additional meaning that it gains from contexts. Term Cosmic Irony. Term Denotation. Definition a meaning as defined in the dictionary. Term Diction.

Definition Vocabulary or word choice. Concrete instead of abstract ex: diaper years instead of infancy. Term Didactic Poetry. Definition Poem written to state a message or teach a body of knowledge. Term Dramatic Irony. Definition irony forms between contrasting levels of knowledge of the character and the audience. Term Dramatic Monologue. Definition Written as a speech made by a character not the author at a decisive moment. Term Dramatic Poetry. Definition uses the voice of an imaginary character, without narration by the author. Term Figures of Speech. Definition when the writer for the sake of freshness or emphasis departs from the usual denotations of words.

He also led the campaign to restore active and engaged literary reading by creating The Big Read, which has helped reverse a quarter century of decline in U.
