## REFERENCES

Bibliography formatted in accordance with the convention adopted by the editors and published at the end of the text, preceded by the heading "References".

Bibliography should contain all texts cited in your work.

All descriptions in Latin alphabet (transliteration of bibliographic descriptions if necessary).

The list should be in alphabetical order in relation to the name of the first Author of each work.

## TABLES, DRAWINGS, PHOTOGRAPHS, SCHEMES, etc.

Tables, drawings, photographs, diagrams, etc. should be sequentially numbered throughout the text. Table titles should be placed above the table, etc., while the source information should be placed below it.

Captions for charts, diagrams and photos along with information about the source should be placed under charts, etc.

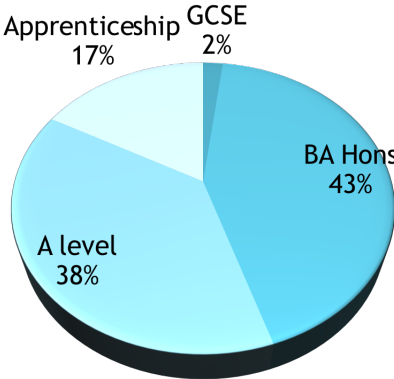


Chart 1. Education of parents of the examined group of junior high school students

## **Dates**

In some magazines it may be desirable to include information about the date of admission notifications (accepted), accepted texts and published publications posted on the last page of the article.

Date of sending the article to the Editor: - it may be needed, but it does not have to

The date of acceptance of the article by the Editorial Board: - may or may not be

## **Financing**

Information about the sources of financing placed in the "Financing" section placed on the last page of the article (between the main text and the bibliography).

The author's statement about the sources of financing of the research presented in the scientific article or the creation of a scientific article: must be if it is financed through a project - this information are needed only when your article is financed/ sponsored by someone else or other organization ex. Univeristy
