
HALF YEARLY STATS | SATURDAY & OPEN COMPETITIONS

Whilst regular competition play has been limited over the first half of the year, PGC introduced a half-yearly Eclectic Competition which runs in conjunction with the weekly Saturday or Open Competitions whereby a ball from the ball

competition is put aside each week to be held in a prize pool & distributed to the divisional winners & runners up (see *below*). The Eclectic Competition records the best score the player has carded for each individual hole throughout the period & subsequently provides the combined lowest total. Within the calculations an adjusted handicap is included which works out to be 50% of the players lowest daily handicap throughout the period.

Below is a graphical analysis of the best scores lodged by each player throughout this period with birdies or better (green/blue), pars (grey) & bogeys or worse (red).

The 2nd/11th proved to be the most favourable scoring hole amongst players offering up a collective 34 birdies (2nd-19 & 11th-15). The 5th & 10th equally accepted the most pars both tallying 45 respectively. Unsurprisingly the 3rd/12th proved the toughest challenge taking a combined 93 bogeys worse & the least birdies (4). 

AMBROSE CHAMPIONSHIP

CONDITIONS OF PLAY.

ENTRY FEE: To be paid to the Starter on the day of play. Cash only

The scratch championship is open to male amateur golfers who are full playing, provisional playing, country or junior members of Clubs affiliated with the Hunter River District Golf Association Incorporated. Handicap event open to male amateur golfers with a current Golf Australia Handicap.

- 1. Each Team will select a Captain, before commencing play.
- Two (2) signatures are required on each completed score card, before it is handed in.
- Each individual player's name and handicap <u>MUST</u> be shown on the score card. The team handicap will be one eighth (1/8) of the combined handicap of the 4 players. Handicaps adjusted on the day relative to the slope rating of the course being played.
- Preferred lies, within one (1) Club length, no nearer the hole, are permitted through the green. The ball may be cleaned.
- Ties, for all trophies, will be decided by Count-back, as defined in the Golf Australia Handbook.

METHOD OF PLAY.

The following "Special Rules", so far as they are not at variance with the Rules of Golf, will apply:

- 1. The players tee off, in order decided by the Captain.
- 2. The captain selects the ball to be played and each Team member plays a stroke from within one (1) Club length of where this ball lies, no nearer the hole, with a preferred lie. The position of the chosen ball to be marked on the spot. The same procedure will be followed on subsequent strokes until the ball is on the putting green.
- 3. On the putting green, all putts are to be played from a spot within 15 centimetres (approx. 6 inches) of where the selected ball lies, no nearer the hole. Should a putt miss the hole and lie adjacent, within a few centimetres, it may be tapped in, to save time, and the remaining putts may then be played from the original position.
- 4. IN THE AMBROSE CHAMPIONSHIP THE TEE SHOT OF EACH PLAYER MUST BE USED AT LEAST THREE (3) TIMES OVER THE 18 HOLES. THE CARD IS TO BE MARKED INDICATING WHOSE TEE SHOT WAS USED ON EACH HOLE UNTIL ALL PLAYERS HAVE USED A MINIMUM OF THREE (3) TEE SHOTS.

Please make decisions on which ball to play as quickly as possible and keep up with the group in front.
