



Six Pledges – The 1st One...Give...




The 1st Pledge of "I Am a Church Member" by Thom S. Rainer

■ The First Pledge I am a church member. I like the metaphor of membership. It's not membership as in a civic organization or a country club. It's the kind of membership given to us in 1 Corinthians 12: "Now you are the body of Christ, and individual members of it" (1 Cor. 12:27). Because I am a member of the body of Christ, I must be a functioning member, whether I am an "eye," an "ear," or a "hand." As a functioning member, I will give. I will serve. I will minister. I will evangelize. I will study. I will seek to be a blessing to others. I will remember that, "if one member suffers, all the members suffer with it; if one member is honored, all the members rejoice with it" (1 Cor. 12:26).

 - Mark 12:38-44, cf. Luke 21:1-3

Mark 12:41 – 44 | The Widow's Offering

- ⁴¹ Jesus sat down opposite the place where the offerings were put and watched the crowd putting their money into the temple treasury. Many rich people threw in large amounts. ⁴² But a poor widow came and put in two very small copper coins, worth only a few cents.
- 43 Calling his disciples to him, Jesus said, "Truly I tell you, this poor widow has put more into the treasury than all the others. 44 They all gave out of their wealth; but she, out of her poverty, put in everything—all she had to live on."

"But you ask, 'How are we to return?' 8"Will a mere mortal rob God? Yet you rob me.



3. Provide an Overview of our Role as Financial Servant Leaders

• Book of Discipline: ¶ 258.4. Committee on Finance | The Book of Discipline of The United Methodist Church -- 2016

The committee on finance shall give stewardship of financial resources as their priority throughout the year. It may delegate the responsibility to either a sub-group or task force that would plan, strategize, and implement ways to generate more resources for mission and ministries of the local churches and beyond. It is strongly recommended that the committee on finance, in collaboration with the church council, find creative ways to turn their congregations into tithing congregations with an attitude of generosity. All financial askings to be included in the annual budget of the local church shall be submitted to the committee on finance. The committee on finance shall compile annually a complete budget for the local church and submit it to the church council for review and adoption. The committee on finance shall be charged with responsibility for developing and implementing plans that will raise sufficient income to meet the budget adopted by the church council. It shall administer the funds received according to instructions from the church council.

- It shall <u>administer the funds</u> received according to instructions from the church council.



So we care enough about people's lives to risk interpreting God's love, to take a stand, to call each of us into a response, no matter how controversial or complex. The church us think and act out a faith perspective, not just responding to the other 'mind-makers-up' that exist in our society."


3. Provide an Overview of our Role as Financial Servant Leaders

- The Missio Dei | God's Mission | A CALL TO DANCE WITH GOD!
- The mission theology expressed in the <u>Latin Missio Dei</u> articulates the belief that mission is God's mission and we are God's instruments in that mission. The starting point of Missio Dei is a Trinitarian God: mission is the purpose and action of the triune God. The internal relationships of the Trinity also embody the way God acts in the world. The church, as a community of God's followers, becomes an instrument of God rather than the proprietor of the action. Mission then moves from something that churches do for the sake of God, to understanding the very nature of God as missionary and sending. It changes missions in the plural as if every church has a mission to mission in the singular. Because God is one, mission is one. In 1964 Stephen Neill, a mission historian from Britain wrote in his book A History of Christian Missions: "The age of missions ended. The age of mission began."5


