Laos (historical name "Lane Xang" means land of millions of elephants) is a southeast Asian landlocked country between Thailand, Cambodia, Vietnam and China. The Vietnam War (1955-1975) also affected Laos and Cambodia: destabilisation, foreign intervention, civil war ...

As a consequence, a **communist government** took over in **1975** - since then, a **dictatorship** in close cooperation with neighbouring Vietnam has set up a repressive apparatus, is violating human rights (drugs, expropriation, human trafficking, land grabbing, media etc) and is suppressing all opposition. On the international stage the country voted in the UN General Assembly against Russia's exclusion from the Human Rights Council.

As the European Union is a major international player for rule of law, human rights and democracy, we have decided to come to Brussels.
