MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, May 12, 2022, at the Municipal Office (Temporarily located in the Municipal Shop), in the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan, with one councillor absent and Division 3 vacant.

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. with Reeve Arthur presiding.

Minutes of the Special Meetings held on April 21st, 2022 and May 6th, 2022 were approved as circulated. The Statement of Financial Activities for the month of April was accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Council authorized the design and purchase of a new sign for the Oakley Cemetery, acknowledged a number of road ban orders and road closed notices, and authorized application to PDAP to be designated an eligible assistance area from the severe weather events in April. The pasture lease agreement was signed and donations to STARS and St. Raphael's Parish were authorized. Council accepted the provincial education mill rates and appointed Pest Control officers for the clubroot survey. An employee contract was acknowledged and a letter was authorized to be sent to the Honourable Marco Mendicino, Minister of Public Safety, stating that the Council of the Rural Municipality of Reciprocity No. 32 are not in favour of reduced border crossing hours at Ports of Entry.

Public Works Foreman, White, attended the meeting to discuss various matters pertaining to the workshop.

A number of road right-of-way applications were approved.

Correspondence was received and filed.
