#### **RAISING OUR SPIRITS TOGETHER:**

Pastor Hahn has been collaborating with researchers at the University of Michigan School of Social Work to create a group program, called "Raising Our Spirits Together" to help people in Hillsdale and surrounding communities who are feeling down. Raising Our Spirits Together is a virtual small group program led by local pastors, including Pastor Hahn, where people who are feeling down or low come together to learn research supported tools and strategies to improve their mood and feel better. We are currently conducting a research study of "Raising Our Spirits Together" and looking for people who would be interested in participating in the study. People can receive up to \$175 for participating. Those interested in participating in the study have a 50/50 chance of attending 8, weekly small group sessions held using Zoom videoconference software. Those that do not receive the program will receive a self-help workbook in the mail.
